VI. COMPETITION FORMAT

Individual events

The International Divers Day 2025 will be run according to the tournament format.

- Preliminaries Entries of divers in the competition shall be accepted only from the Federations, Members of WA.
- The maximum number of divers who can participate in an individual event is four (4).
- Any Federation with more than two divers in an event may be permitted to advance to the semifinals only the top two (2) performers in that event.

Semi-Finals

The top 12 divers advance to the Semi-Finals (Groups A and B).

• Group A 12-10-8-6-4-2• Group B 11-9-7-5-3-1





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Finals

The top 3 divers from Groups A and B advance to the Finals (total of 6 divers in Final).

Replacement of injured diver

In the case of an injury following the Preliminary competition, the next qualified diver will take the place.

In the case of an injury following the Semi A or Semi B, the next qualified diver of the same Semi-final will take the place.

Dives

*	Men's individual events - 3m and 10m	6 dives without limit
**	Women's individual events - 3m and 10m	5 dives without limit

Synchronised diving events

There will be only Finals competitions. Each federation may only allow 1 team to participate in the competition.

The Host Federation may enter two (2) teams in the direct final of a synchro event but only the best team may proceed to the podium.

*	Men's synchro events - 3m and 10m	2 dives with limit 2,0 +
		4 dives without limit
*	Women's synchro events - 3m and 10m	2 dives with limit 2,0 +
		3 dives without limit

Mixed Team event

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IX. COMPETITION RULES

Rules

All events shall be conducted in accordance with the WA Rules. (www.worldaguatics.com/rules).

World Aquatics Delegate

World Aquatics following the recommendation by the World Aquatics TDC, shall appoint a World Aquatics Delegate for this event. The World Aquatics Delegate shall conduct judging evaluations and shall present a written technical report and summary of evaluations to the World Aquatics TDC Commission and the TDC Judges' Sub- Committee Coordinator responsible for compilation of judging evaluations.

Prize Money

- The winner of each discipline will be awarded a special prize. All divers placed 1 to 6 will receive certificates.
- ❖ The winner, second and third place receive prize money in women's and men's springboard-3m, platform diving, synchronized diving and Team event.

Winner	EURO	1.000,-
2nd place	EURO	500,-
3rd place	EURO	250,-

Judges

Only World Aquatics Certified A or G Judges will be accepted. The Judging panel of Individual events shall be from different countries, if available. If judges from seven different nations are not available, the judging panel will be reduced to five judges. In the Finals, the panel of judges shall consist of judges whose nationality is different to the nationality of any of the participating divers, if available. In synchronized diving there shall be nine judges from different countries, if available. If not possible, there can be two judges from the same country, provided one is judging the execution and the other the synchronization.

If a National Federation team is greater than three athletes, then the National Federation must provide a judge. Each National Federation can provide up to maximum of 2 judges. The judge might, however, also serve as a coach if he/she is not judging for the same event.

A federation that does not provide a judge will be fined 200 Euro, payable to the Organizing Committee.





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X. ORGANISERS SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- Teams can enter a maximum of 4 divers per nation in individual events.
- ❖ The technical meeting will take place at the InterCityHotel on Wednesday March 12nd, 2025 at 5:00 PM

XI. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation cards will be issued upon teams' arrival. The list of accredited persons is based on the final entry forms.

XII. DOPING

Doping control will be conducted in accordance with WA rules.

XIII. MEDICAL CARE, LIFEGUARDS

A safety rehearsal will take place near the swimming pool on Tuesday 11st, 2025 by expert lifeguards. An emergency doctor will be available above the technical podium during all competitions. Lifeguards will be available during training sessions and competitions next to our synchro springboards.
